- [Wallykazam! The Big Goblin Problem](#)

This story exercises kids' prereading skills by exploring letter sounds, synonyms, and word identification, as well as basic counting skills and rhyming. The characters encourage viewers' involvement by speaking directly to them and prompting questions such as, "Which word starts with the 'S' sound?" Wally and his friends also teach kids about friendship through their cooperative relationships, and Uncle Steve's presence demonstrates the value of having good role models to follow. Even Wally's nemesis, Bobgoblin, illustrates the dangers of selfish behavior and the importance of setting things right when you've done something wrong.

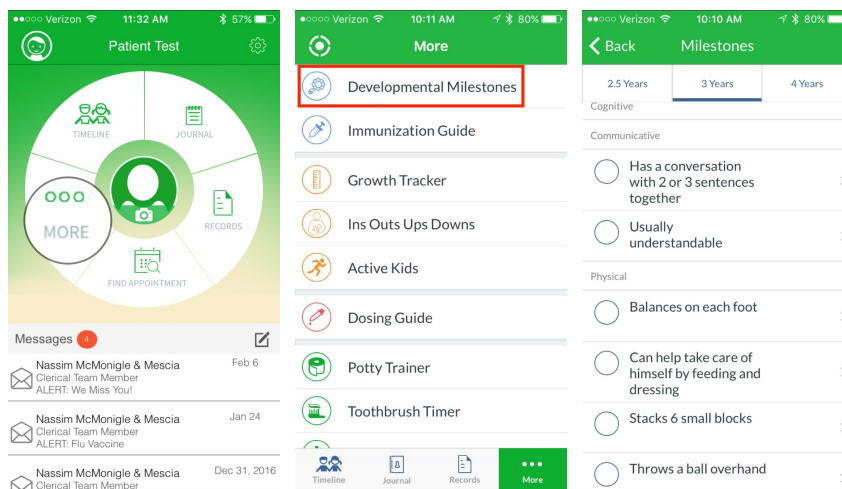


## Healow Kids Feature Review
