While we recommend the meningitis vaccine for all of preteen and teenage patients, if you have a college age child, it's even more important. Due to the close living situations on most college campuses, our children are even more susceptible to the transfer of the meningitis virus. If your child has not received the meningitis vaccine, aka Menactra or Trumenba, please contact our

office immediately to schedule an appointment for your child to receive the vaccine. This is a two dose vaccination. We will schedule the second dosage when the first dose is given.
