"Take-Out" Healthcare

No one will argue that a take-out meal is not the healthiest way to eat, so why is it that "take-out" healthcare is okay? We often hear it said that asports physical is just a matter of paperwork, but we disagree.



Any time a physical is required for your child to participate in a sport, camp, or other activity there is good reason. It is vitally important for the camp authorities to fully understand your child's health status. How can a drop in health dinic fully and adequately complete a child's health history and be aware of any

potential risks to the child's health if they have not treated the child and do not have access to his/her entire medical record?

Did you know that for virtually any child covered by an insurance plan the annual physical is FREE? In addition, if we have performed the exam, we will complete any necessary paperwork for your child to participate in a school sport and/or summer camp for a full year! Our annual exam is comprehensive and encompasses the entirety of your child's health, not just a cursory glance. So why pay \$20 to a dinic for a physical when your child can be seen by his/her physician for free and have a more comprehensive exam in the process?

We do appreciate you calling to schedule an appointment in advance, but if you find yourself in a bind to get the physical done in time feel free to take advantage of our Walk-In hours, Mon-Sat 8-10am and Mon-Thurs 4-6pm.
