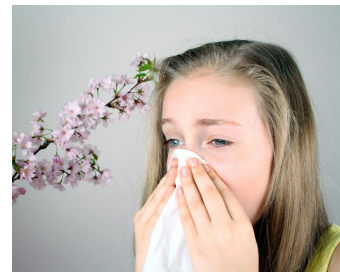
Flu Vaccine Still Available
