Thank you for all who completed our communications survey last month. Your feedback was helpful. We are working on improving our phone system, with the final touches being completed next week!!

We'd also like to encourage you to utilize the services available on our portal and through Healow. Healow is an application for your phone and can be downloaded through your app store. *Healow Kids is for children 12 and under. The standard Healow app is for children 13 and above.* You may link multiple children to the Healow app. Information on how to do that is available through the Support function on the app.

Our **practice portal** is available via any internet enabled computer, pc or Mac. Both applications, portal and Healow, provide you with the ability to leave a message for a member of our staff or a doctor. This form of messaging means your inquiry will be directed to the right person. If however, you have an urgent question, we still recommend you call the main number (812) 949-0405 and press option 5 to speak with a staff member. Please use option 2 for all scheduling inquiries.



For prescription refills, including controlled substances, please request your refill through the portal or Healow app. You will get a message from us when the prescription has been sent to your pharmacy. Calling in will not get your prescription refilled any faster and may actually be slower than requesting the refill electronically. As always, please allow 2-3 days for the prescription to be available, especially for controlled substances, so plan ahead when you see your child's prescription is running low.

Flu Vaccine Clinic

While NAFCS is on fall break, October 2nd-13th, we think it's a good time to launch our annual Flu Vaccine Clinic. So, drop in for your child's flu shot (Flumist is not available this year) any time between 8am-8pm Monday through Thursday, 8am-5pm Friday, or Saturday 8am-12pm.



2018-2019 School Vaccine Requirements are Changing



It may seem like it's too early to talk about the 2018-19 school year, but there are some changes to the school vaccine requirements that may take some planning on your part. Starting next school year, children entering kindergarten through 6th grade are required to have the entire Hepatitis A vaccine, delivered in 2 doses.

In addition, all teens entering 12th grade will be required to have received the Meningitis B vaccine - also given in 2 doses. Please keep these updates in mind when scheduling your child's upcoming well child check-ups, because you will have to have 2 separate appointments to accommodate both doses.
